

2010 Godmobile Praise Report

Dear friends ~

High praises to our magnificent, almighty God. It was an amazing week. Thank you SO much for your help, prayers, and support! God did awesome things this week in revealing Himself to many people.

Overall, we had 73 people pray to trust Jesus Christ for forgiveness and eternal life. Please pray that God will continue to minister to each of them, nurture their new faith, and draw them to Himself. We will be sending contact information to our partner churches and are praying that God will provide for the needed follow up for each of these precious souls.

There were probably twice that many who heard our presentation of the Gospel, but rejected the opportunity to turn to Christ, so we covet your prayers for each of them, too. Additionally, there were many more who avoided our booth altogether, averted their eyes, or walked on the other side of the drive. We know that God can continue to speak to them, as well. Our sign, "Are You Going to Heaven?" broadcast the question to all who saw it.

On the last night, since we couldn't drive the van into the grounds until 11:00 p.m., we decided to just hang out until we could drive in and pick up everything instead of having to carry all the equipment out to the van. We took down most everything in the booth except for the canopy/signs and one table. A couple groups came late, so we had to put up a second table again, and there were more salvations at the last minute.

Saturday evening we had a family of four--the mom, dad, and nine and six year old daughters--all pray together to put their trust in Jesus Christ. It amazes me how a clear presentation of God's plan to save and forgive us has touched so many last week. Simply asking, "Would you like to know that your sins are forgiven?" and "Would you like to know that your eternity is secure?" resulted in many decisions to trust Christ. I also remember the faces and look in the eyes of the two 15 year old twin girls and the two teenage boys that prayed to trust Christ, and the three young girls who accepted Christ, one whose daddy died the day before.

After presenting the gospel or after leading someone in prayer, I often ask, "Have you ever heard that before?" and they always say no, they have not. Sometimes they go to a solid, Bible preaching church, so I think they have been told, but have not "heard."

After spending the week telling people that God told us that he put the knowledge of Himself in all of us and that the heavens declare the glory of the Lord and the firmament displays His handiwork, I got home only to find the clearest sky I have seen in a long time with more stars than I remember seeing in ages. I felt that God was affirming that Truth once again, and I am overwhelmed with His goodness!

Let's pray for all those new believers, that God will water and grow all the seeds sown, and that God will set free those in captivity and bondage to the enemy's deception.

God has already provided most of what was needed with \$1214.35 in donations. We still need \$386.94 to cover the 1,000 tract booklets, hardware, two stools and need about \$25 for waterproofing spray for the canopy.

Now that we are outfitted, we are ready to set up our evangelism booth again where God opens doors. We hope to work at the Kalamazoo Fair again next year and plan to help with the Allegan Fair on September 10-18. I will let you know about the staffing and prayer needs as that time approaches, when I hear from the organizers.
