ETHICS AND ATTIRE

- Workers should be well-groomed.
- Wear clean, professional and modest clothing. You will be representing our sponsor churches and your Lord.
- Women, please check necklines in a mirror while bending since you will be leaning over a table. 1 Timothy 2:9, 10 says “in like manner also, that the women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with propriety and moderation, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or costly clothing, but, which is proper for women professing godliness, with good works.”
- Sun Glasses should not be worn, but caps or visers are permitted. Eye contact is important.
- Avoid frivolous, humorous, slanderous or vulgar headgear, or clothing with inappropriate or controversial wording.
- Please—no eating, drinking or chewing gum **while working with visitors.**
- Please keep personal materials, except test booklets and pencils off the counters.
- Bibles should be kept with personal items and brought out as needed during a discussion.
- Test booklets will be recycled by erasing.
- Workers are to be provided one test booklet from which they may order additional copies for themselves. Please do not deplete the ministry supply for personal use.
- We are allowed to operate only within our rented space. You may smile and speak to someone who looks your way and ask if they would like to take the test. Say, “Would you like to take our two-question test?” or “Would you like to take our test, it’s free.”
- Invite people to take the Test only as they pass our booth.
- Do not distribute materials on the fairgrounds, in parking lots, or outside our booth.
- Do not touch any test taker.
- Do not shout to people passing by or to those at neighboring booths.
- Inappropriate Invitations: Please do not give joking invitations such as, “Reserve a mansion in Heaven,” or “Get your passport to heaven,” since it may confuse the issue and cause misfocus.
- Do not use terms such as, “Are you saved?” Even the terms, “Christian,” “faith,” and “believe” may be misunderstood if not defined.
- If someone comes to Christ and you give him a Bible, consider inscribing it with the date and your name...you might use Titus 3:5-7 “not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior, that having been justified by His grace we should become heirs according to the hope of eternal life.” or another verse God puts on your heart.
- To prepare, please read 2 Corinthians 5.
